### MOCA GA Working Artists Project: an award for metropolitan Atlanta visual artists of merit

Deadline: Monday, March 1, 2010

MOCA GA is pleased to announce the 2010/2011 *MOCA GA Working Artists Project (WAP)*. WAP is an awards program to support established visual artists of merit who reside in the **Atlanta metropolitan area**. This initiative will provide an unparalleled level of support for individual artists, expand the Museum's mission, and promote Atlanta as a city where artists can live, work, and thrive. As with past years, jurors will select three visual artists to receive the Award. Representing our city's best and brightest; these artists will be supported with an exhibition, promotion, a studio assistant, and a major stipend to create work over the course of the year. This program is supported by a major grant from The Charles Lorigans Foundation with additional funding from the National Endowment for the Arts.

**Exhibitions Beginning:** April 2011

#### Details of Award

The *MOCA GA Working Artists Project Award* provides an unparalleled level of support during the year for three visual artists, and includes:

- A stipend for each artist in the amount of \$12,000,
- A paid studio assistant for up to 300 hours during the year of the project,
- The opportunity to interface with collectors, other artists, and the general public through programming and studio visits,
- Documentation of the artists' history and work in MOCA GA's *Oral History Project*, as well as the Museum's Education/Resource Center,
- Inclusion of one work of each artist in the Museum's permanent collection,
- Presentation of their work in a solo exhibition at MOCA GA at the end of the project's term,
- An accompanying full-color catalogue documenting the exhibition of all three artists.

#### Eligibility Requirements

Recipients of the *MOCA GA Working Artists Project Award* will be selected based on artistic merit, professionalism, and their proven ability to complete the project. In addition, applicants must demonstrate the following criteria:

- The artist must currently reside in the Atlanta metropolitan area, and must have resided in the Atlanta metropolitan area for at least one year (**The metropolitan**

**Atlanta area includes the following counties:** Barrow, Bartow, Butts, Carroll, Cherokee, Clayton, Cobb, Coweta, DeKalb, Douglas, Fayette, Forsyth, Fulton, Gwinnett, Hall, Henry, Newton, Morgan, Paulding, Pickens, Rockdale, Spalding, and Walton),

- The artist must retain residency in the Atlanta metropolitan area for the entire length of the project period,
- A minimum of five years of exhibition record,
- At least one solo show in a gallery or museum in Atlanta, or of regional, national, or international renown\*,
- Recognition of quality of work through publication or review.

**\* Please note: Artists who have previously won a Working Artist Project award are not eligible for this grant.**

If selected, the *Working Artist Project* Artists must agree to the following conditions:

- Retention of residency in the Atlanta metropolitan area for the period of the grant;
- Commitment to exhibition dates identified;
- Commitment to produce new work expressly for the MOCA GA exhibition;
- Commitment to provide one work of art to MOCA GA's permanent collection – selection to be determined through review of work by the Museum's collection committee;
- Commitment to select and mentor studio assistant;
- Commitment to participate in quarterly educational programming for the public, such as artist talks or studio visits.

### How to Apply

The following materials must be submitted by mail or in person, no later than **5:00 pm, Monday, March 1, 2010**. (NOTE: This is not a postmark date, but the date by which materials must be received):

- Completed Entry Form (available for download at [www.mocaga.org](http://www.mocaga.org)),
- Current and complete resume reflecting at least five years exhibition record,
- One-page statement of how the grant would benefit your work,
- Copy of up to three publications or reviews written about your work or an exhibition in which you are mentioned,
- A CD of ten (10) digital images of work (**jpg format**) produced within the last two years,
- Accompanying numbered list of images with title, media, size, description, and date of work.
