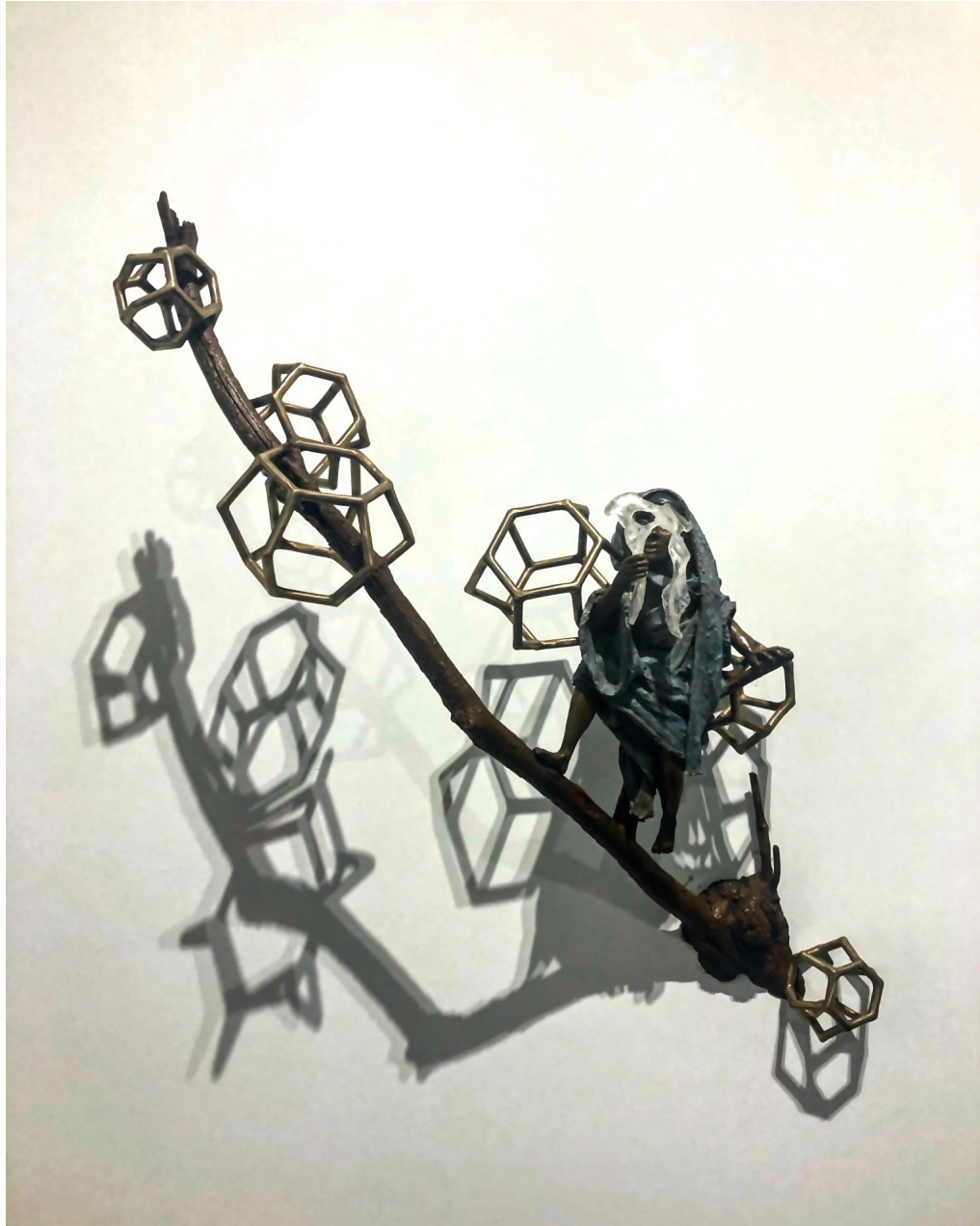

Biography

Morgan Lugo is a Sicilian/Puerto Rican sculptor who hails from Atlanta, Georgia. In 2015, Morgan earned a BFA in Sculpture from Georgia State University. Since Morgan has started creating sculptures, she has been a part of a multitude of different shows and international cast iron performances. This includes two separate showings at The High Museum of Art in Atlanta, Georgia; SPECTRUM Miami in conjunction with Art Basel and Miami Art Week; and The Elysium Exhibition and Performance Iron Pour in Berlin, Germany in conjunction with Berlin Art Week. Morgan is also involved with an international group of artists who run intricate live molten iron pours as performance art pieces. Morgan's work is created through a multitude of experimental techniques from mold making, clay sculpting, fabrication welding, assemblage, and metal casting. With her primary focus on metalworking, a field that is still dominated by gender stereotypes and blockades for women, Morgan's resolve is to excel in this craft while opening the door to other underrepresented groups who wish to take part in this field. She plans to keep pushing and creating unique sculptural pieces with strong influences from dream-state consciousness, the complexities of the internal-self, and the intangible common thread of human experience.

Biografía

Morgan Lugo es un escultor siciliano/puertorriqueño que viene de Atlanta, Georgia. En 2015, Morgan obtuvo una licenciatura en escultura de la Universidad Estatal de Georgia. Desde que Morgan comenzó a crear esculturas, ha participado en una multitud de espectáculos y actuaciones internacionales de hierro fundido. Esto incluye dos exposiciones separadas en el High Museum of Art de Atlanta, Georgia; SPECTRUM Miami en conjunción con Art Basel y Miami Art Week; y The Elysium Exhibition and Performance Iron Pour en Berlín, Alemania en conjunción con Berlin Art Week. Morgan también está involucrado con un grupo internacional de artistas que realizan intrincados vertidos de hierro fundido en vivo como piezas de arte de performance. El trabajo de Morgan se crea a través de una multitud de técnicas experimentales de fabricación de moldes, escultura en arcilla, soldadura de fabricación, ensamblaje y fundición de metal. Con su enfoque principal en la metalurgia, un campo que todavía está dominado por los estereotipos de género y los bloqueos para las mujeres, la resolución de Morgan es sobresalir en este oficio mientras

abre la puerta a otros grupos poco representados que desean participar en este campo. Ella planea seguir impulsando y creando piezas escultóricas únicas con fuertes influencias de la conciencia del estado de sueño, las complejidades del yo interno y el hilo común intangible de la experiencia humana.

General Artist Statement

In 2014, Morgan received a traumatic concussion causing her temporary memory loss and vertigo. Since this experience, Morgan's work has been focused on depicting fragmented memories. She is infatuated with using cast metal sculptures to turn something so inherently impermanent as a memory into something that will stand the test of time. These sculptural pieces explore the relationship of the conscious and unconscious mind, as well as what the physical manifestation of a memory would look like. Morgan is a metal sculptor whose work explores memory, time, dream-state consciousness and the interaction of these private experiences with the physical world.

Declaración general del artista

En 2014, Morgan recibió una conmoción cerebral traumática que le causó pérdida de memoria temporal y vértigo. Desde esta experiencia, el trabajo de Morgan se ha centrado en la representación de recuerdos fragmentados. Está encaprichada con el uso de esculturas de metal fundido para convertir algo tan intrínsecamente impermanente como un recuerdo en algo que resista el paso del tiempo. Estas piezas escultóricas exploran la relación de la mente consciente e inconsciente, así como cómo sería la manifestación física de un recuerdo. Morgan es un escultor de metal cuyo trabajo explora la memoria, el tiempo, la conciencia del estado de sueño y la interacción de estas experiencias privadas con el mundo físico.
