## **Biography**

Born in Havana, Cuba. Graduated with a degree in Architecture from Havana University. Fled from the Castro regime and arrived in the U.S. in 1961.

Earned a Masters Degree in Landscape Architecture, University of Michigan. Recruited upon graduation to work in Montreal, Canada, designing public spaces for "Expo"1967 World's Fair. Subsequently worked as a Landscape Architect and Interiors Architect in the U.S.

Studied in Georgia State University and with several artists in the Atlanta area. Gradually, painting became her second career. She began showing her work in 1991. Art is now her full-time career.

She paints and draws in plein-air and in her studio.

Her principal media are acrylic and mixed media but, she draws almost daily with pen and ink, carrying a sketch book with her at all times.

Myrtha believes that beauty is found everywhere and art is all around us.
