Biography

Melvin Toledo's interest in art began as a teenager with drawings of characters from the popular Japanese manga series, Dragon Ball Z. Encouraged by family members and others who had seen his drawings, he left his small hometown in northern Nicaragua to attend the School of Fine Arts in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. It was at La Escuela de Bellas Artes that he received his first art lessons. In 2000, he began working as a still life painter for his uncle's home decorating company where he painted bodegones, using a mixture of oil paint and lithographic ink. These paintings were sold by door to door salesmen who traveled across Honduras. In 2007, he came to the U.S. where he began to paint exclusively in oils.
